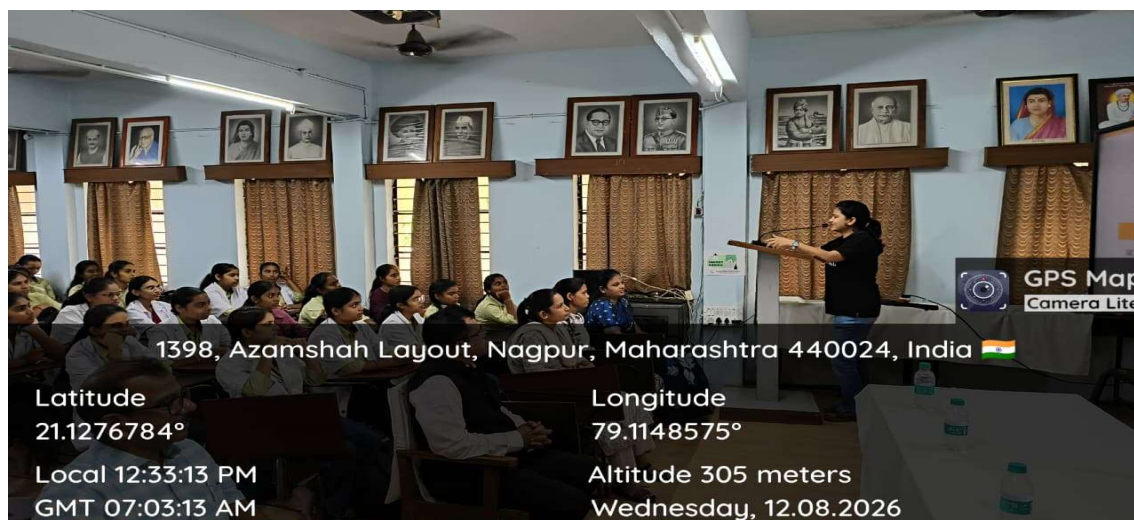
Prof. Pravin U. Meshram, Officiating Principal, expressed her key support for the guidance program, highlighting the value of career readiness for young women scholars.
